

An Ordinance to ~~Strike, amend, and insert~~ different sections of Chapter 13A of the Ordinances of the Town of Chapmanville, WV. Be it ordained by the Town of Chapmanville, that upon passage this will be considered the entirety of Chapter 13A of the ordinances of the Town of Chapmanville

Chapter 13A

Garbage and Refuse Collection: Requirement and Regulation

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS:

- a) Town is the town of Chapmanville.
- b) The term "Garbage" shall mean all animal and vegetable wastes resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking, or consumption of foods.
- c) The term "Rubbish" shall include glass, metal, paper, plant growth, wood, non-putrescible solid wastes.

SECTION 2. PREPARATION OF REFUSE:

- a) All refuse shall be drained free of liquids before disposal.
- b) Garbage shall be wrapped in paper or similar material.
- c) All cans, bottles or other food containers shall be rinsed free of liquid or food, particles and drained before disposal.
- d) Rubbish shall be,
 - i) Placed in approved containers or
 - ii) Cut and bailed, tied, bundled, stacked or packaged so as not to exceed 36 inches in length and 50 pounds in weight.
- e) Highly inflammable or explosive materials shall not be placed in refuse containers for regular collections.

SECTION 3. REFUSE COLLECTION:

- a) Containers should be placed on property near access street on day of collection.
- b) Residence refuse will be collected one day a week and on the same day each week.
- c) Non-residential refuse will be collected two days a week and on the same days each week.

SECTION 4. FEES

~~Town Council has the authority to increase garbage rates without having to read any ordinance or provision thereof for three consecutive regular meetings of the Chapmanville Town Council. However, prior to any vote on subsequent rate increases the Mayor shall certify to the Chapmanville Town Council in writing the amount of increase with said justification for it. Council shall approve or reject increases via a majority vote of those present, a quorum first having been established.~~

- a) The fee for collection, removal, and disposal of any residential refuse by the town for a once a week pick-up shall be \$25.00 per month per family. An additional fee will be charged for extra pick-ups or excessive loads.
- b) The fee for collection, removal, and disposal of any non-residential refuse by the town shall be determined on the basis of two criteria:
 - i) the volume of the dumpster, or the number of cans, and
 - ii) the number of times the garbage is collected per week.

- c) The following table will be used to determine the rate of the commercial fee.

COMMERCIAL RATE OPTIONS

| Dumpster Yardage or Garbage Can | Number of Weekly pick-ups | Monthly Fee |
|---------------------------------|---------------------------|-------------|
| 1 Can | 2 Times/ Week | \$50 |
| 2 Cans | 2 Times/ Week | \$75 |
| 2 Yard Dumpster | 2 Times/ Week | \$100 |
| 4 Yard Dumpster | 2 Times/ Week | \$200 |
| 6 Yard Dumpster | 2 Times/ Week | \$300 |
| 8 Yard Dumpster | 2 Times/ Week | \$400 |
| 2 Yard Dumpster | 3 Times/ Week | \$150 |
| 4 Yard Dumpster | 3 Times/ Week | \$300 |
| 6 Yard Dumpster | 3 Times/ Week | \$450 |
| 8 Yard Dumpster | 3 Times/ Week | \$600 |
| 2 Yard Dumpster | 4 Times/ Week | \$200 |
| 4 Yard Dumpster | 4 Times/ Week | \$400 |
| 6 Yard Dumpster | 4 Times/ Week | \$600 |
| 8 Yard Dumpster | 4 Times/ Week | \$800 |

- d) All fees for the foregoing services by the Town shall be due and payable each month before the 20th of the month. Payment after the 20th will result in a 10% fine.
- e) Deposits for Garbage Collection will be 50\$ for residential and \$100 for commercial. The Deposit will be refunded if the account is paid in full when their account is closed.


Section 5. FINES

- a) New residents and or businesses in town who fail to sign up for garbage service after becoming legal residents of the town for 60 (Sixty) days will be fine \$100 (One Hundred Dollars) and \$50 (Fifty Dollars) per day for every day beyond 60 that they have failed to sign up for services.


