## Chapter 21


### Horseback Riding


- a. Finding of Fact-The Town Council of The Town of Chapmanville finds that horseback riding within the town limits of The Town of Chapmanville has become a nuisance, is dangerous to the population of The Town of Chapmanville, impedes the traffic flow in The Town of Chapmanville, and constitutes a health hazard in The Town of Chapmanville and should, therefore, be prevented.
- b. Prohibitions-All persons are hereby prohibited from horseback riding within the town limits of The Town of Chapmanville and all persons are hereby prohibited from leading any horses within the town limits of The Town of Chapmanville without first having obtained a permit from the Mayor to do so as hereinafter set forth.
- c. Permits-The Mayor is hereby authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the issuance of a temporary permit in the event that it becomes necessary for a horse to be led through the Town of Chapmanville or in the event that it becomes necessary for some person to ride a horse through The Town of Chapmanville, provided that methods of cleanup for the horse' waste are provided for prior to the permit being issued.
- d. Penalties-Any person violating this Ordinance by riding a horse within the town limits of The Town of Chapmanville or by leading a horse within the town limits of The Town of Chapmanville shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). The Municipal Court of The Town of Chapmanville shall have jurisdiction to hear all trials concerning the violation of this section.



