WHEREAS, implementation of the fair housing policy of this Town requires the positive commitment, involvement, and support of each and every one of our citizens; and

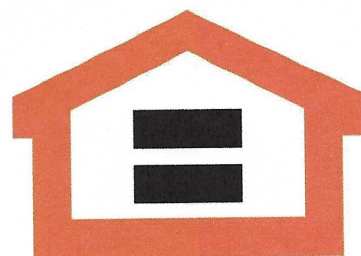
WHEREAS, the departments and agencies of this Town are to provide leadership in the effort to make fair housing a right that can be realized by all our citizens;

in the Town of Chapmanville and urge every citizen to support and endorse the practice and policy of fair housing in their personal lives, as well as in their workday duties.

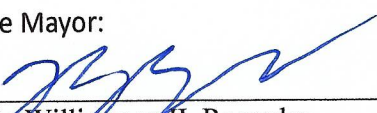
