

An Ordinance to ~~Strike~~, amend, and insert different sections of Chapter 10A of the Ordinances of the Town of Chapmanville, WV. Be it ordained by the Town of Chapmanville, that upon passage/ effective date this will be considered the entirety of Chapter 10A of the ordinances of the Town of Chapmanville.

Chapter 10A

Parking

1. Parking along State Route 10

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHAPMANVILLE:

- a. That it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle partly or entirely on West Virginia Route Ten ~~beginning at MP 33.09 (being the intersection of West Virginia Route Ten and Mays Street) and running North to a telephone pole located approximately 84' South of MP 33.45 (being the South Corner of the now existing West Virginia Supermarket) a total distance of approximately 0.36 miles, or on Crawley Creek Road, within the Limits of the Town of Chapmanville.~~
- b. The Town of Chapmanville shall erect or shall cause to be erected "NO PARKING" signs, when needed, on those areas wherein parking shall be prohibited.
- c. It shall be the duty of the Police Department of the Town of Chapmanville to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.
- d. That it shall be unlawful for anyone to operate a flea market farmer's market or other form of roadside market, or to engage in any form of outside roadside entertainment or public gathering within fifty feet of the paved portion of West Virginia Route TEN within the Town Limits of Chapmanville, provided however, that this provision shall not prohibit any property owner or anyone acting with their permission from freely using any of their property, whether inside or outside, in any manner they choose.
- e. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

2. Parking of Coal Trucks

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF CHAPMANVILLE, that

- a. It shall be illegal for any person, as hereinafter defined, to park or cause to be parked a truck or trailer hauling coal or other raw materials, as hereinafter defined, upon the public property, including the streets and highways within the Town of Chapmanville for more than two (2) hours at one time.
- b. It is further ORDAINED by the Town of Chapmanville that it shall be illegal for any person, as hereinafter defined, to park or cause to be parked a coal truck or trailer hauling coal or other raw materials, as hereinafter defined, upon private property within the Town of Chapmanville for more than two (2) hours at one time without the consent of the owner of the said property.
- c. **Definitions:**
 - i. **Person** - The term person as used herein shall include any individual, partner or corporation which shall cause to be parked the aforesaid vehicles and shall include both the owner of any vehicle who knowingly allows the same to be parked and any driver thereof.
 - ii. **Truck or trailer hauling coal or other raw materials** - These terms as used herein shall include any vehicle licensed or permitted by the Public Service Commission of the State of West Virginia to transport

coal or other raw materials and shall include not only tandem type vehicles but also the tractor and/or trailer used in said transportation of coal or other raw materials.

d. **Penalties:**

Any person as defined herein violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 for the said violation.

3. **Extreme Length of Vehicles**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHAPMANVILLE:

- a. That effective upon passage of this ordinance a motor vehicle, including a combination of vehicles coupled together in a truck/tractor- semi-trailer combined shall not exceed a length of 40 feet extreme overall dimension inclusive of front and rear bumpers, on any of the public streets, highways, avenues, or alleys of the Town of Chapmanville except that upon the state and federal highways in the said town, the length of the vehicle shall be limited only by the state and federal regulations.

b. **Penalty:**

For any violation of this ordinance, a fine of not less than \$50 shall be imposed.

4. **To Prohibit Parking on Southbound Ramp of Rt 119**

- a. Except in the case of an authorized emergency vehicle engaged in official duties, it shall hereafter be unlawful for any bicycle, motor-cycle or any other vehicle to park along the U.S. Route 119 Southbound Ramp ~~for a distance of one hundred twenty (120) feet~~ from the intersection of U.S. Route 119 and West Virginia State Route 10. "NO PARKING" traffic control markings shall be erected ~~for said distance of one hundred twenty (120) feet~~ and any parking of a bicycle, motor-cycle or other vehicle within the designated "no parking" area shall be prohibited.

5. Exemptions

- a. The Mayor of the Town of Chapmanville may grant temporary exemptions to this ordinance for the purpose of religious gatherings, and community events. No exemption may be granted for any business, yard sale, or any other revenue generating gathering or event.
